

# DEVELOPMENT IN DONG HOI CITY, QUANG BINH PROVINCE

## Summary

Dong Hoi city is the provincial capital of Quang Binh province has a total area of 15570.56 hectares naturally, representing 1.93% of the province's area. The population was 112,533 people in 2013, with 723 people density / km<sup>2</sup>, over 68% urban population. Recommend to 2020, non-agricultural land is 6617.97 hectares (up 42.5%), unused land 154.75 ha (accounting for 0.99%). While agricultural land is 8797.84 hectares (accounting for 56.50% of the total natural area), down 1264.42 ha compared to 2013 from: 268.06 ha of paddy land, perennial crops 43.05 ha; 193.67 ha of protective forest land; 486.21 hectares of productive forest land, aquaculture land 259.28 ha and the remaining agricultural land 14.15 ha for non-agricultural purposes. 304.47 ha while exploiting unused land put to use purpose annual crops 76.14 ha, perennial crops 92.41 hectares and 135.92 hectares of forest land. The structure of agricultural land use with 8797.84 ha are arranged logically for rice fields, 975.93 hectares (11.09%) fell 268.06 ha; perennial land 971.76 ha (accounting for 11.05%) fell 43.05 ha; 3332.71 ha of protective forest land (representing 33.88%) fell 193.67 ha, production forest land 2700.73 hectares (30.69%) fell 486.21 ha; aquaculture land 205.78 ha (accounting for 2.34%) fell 259.28 ha; the remaining agricultural land 611.33 ha (accounting for 6.95% of the total agricultural land area) decreased 14.15 hectare than in 2013.
