

FACTORS AFFECTING THE PARTICIPATION IN THE VOCATIONAL TRAINING OF RURAL LABORS IN KHANH VINH DISTRICT, KHANH HOA PROVINCE

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Summary

The study analyzes the factors affecting the participation into vocational training of rural labors in Khanh Vinh mountain district, Khanh Hoa province with the Binary Logistic model. With 300 samples in the 03 communes of Khanh Vinh district, the results show that there are five statistically significant impacts on the attainment of the vocational training: (i) supported policies for vocational training; (ii) distance from home to vocational training school; (iii) education; (iv) age; (v) income. Three factors that did not show statistically significant effects in this study are: (i) career counseling; (ii) recognition of the benefits of apprenticeship; (iii) employment status. Solutions to promote vocational training of rural labors in Khanh Vinh mountain district, Khanh Hoa province are proposed including: (1) strengthening measures to support rural labors during vocational training and after training; (2) improving the organization of vocational training and well implementation of the agricultural and industrial extension activities; (3) selecting suitable programs to the education level of local labors; (4) supporting poor, near poor and low income labors to participate in the vocational training.
